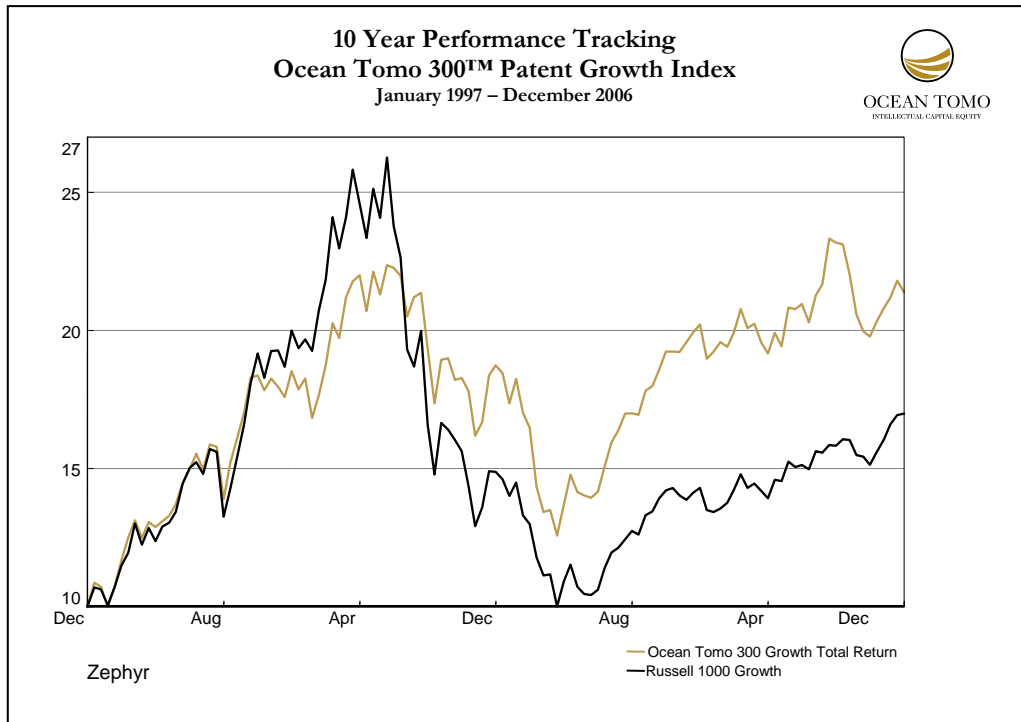
OCEAN TOMO INTRODUCES INDUSTRY'S FIRST INTANGIBLE ASSET GROWTH INDEX

Ocean Tomo 300 Patent Growth Index Priced and Published by the American Stock Exchange*

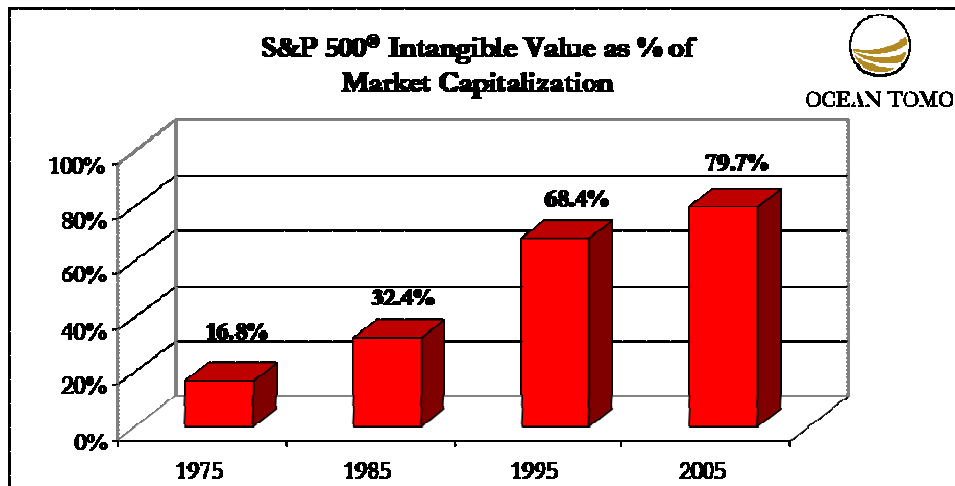

The Index is priced and published by the American Stock Exchange® (Amex®) under the symbol **OTPATG**.

The Index includes the top growth companies of the broad-market Ocean Tomo 300™ Patent Index (AMEX: OTPAT), as determined by the price-to-book ratio, and is diversified across market capitalization. It is the industry’s first growth index based on the value of intellectual property and represents a portfolio of 60 companies with the highest innovation ratio (i.e., patent value relative to book value). The Index has a 10-year tested history and will be a valuable resource for fund analysts, financial advisors and investors. Historical returns have been calculated on a hypothetical basis since October 1, 1995.

“The Ocean Tomo 300™ Patent Growth Index has outperformed the Russell 1000® Growth Index by 240 basis points over a 10-year tested period with less volatility. The creation of the Ocean Tomo 300™ Patent Growth Index represents the next logical step in the market’s recognition of the role innovation plays in our economy,” said James E. Malackowski, President and CEO, Ocean Tomo.



“Today, less than 80% of a company’s market value is composed of tangible assets. As the United States continues to shed its industrial past and emerge as a knowledge-based economy, the examination of intellectual capital as an asset class represented in the Index becomes even more relevant to the market” adds Mr. Malackowski.
